Important Information

- This list of individual potential babysitters is compiled by the officers of C.A.R.E. (Children’s Advocacy for Rights and Empowerment), a student group at the Brown School of Social Work at Washington University. The School and this student group, its officers, members, and all those associated are not responsible for the quality, qualifications, or availability of any babysitter listed.
- The students on this list are graduate students. Most are full-time students and many take night and/or weekend classes. Most are not available for full-time nanny positions. The “available times” that are listed do not guarantee that the student babysitter will always be available at those times.
- Please contact individual babysitters directly. This list is only a compilation of individuals interested in being listed as potential babysitters; these individuals assume all risk and consequences for their performance. **You must negotiate with individual babysitters listed regarding scheduling, availability, fees, and qualifications.** C.A.R.E. and the Brown School of Social Work provide this Sitters List as a resource to the community. These are individual babysitters who have volunteered to be placed on this list, but operate fully as independent individuals.
- A “Yes” in the Special Needs column indicates the student stated he/she has experience working with a special needs population. **It DOES NOT guarantee the student has prior experience with children with special needs.** It is the responsibility of the list user to inquire further experience.
- “CPR” or “CPR/First Aid” in the Certification column indicates the student stated he/she is certified for the stated class.
- This list is revised at the beginning of every semester (spring and fall) due to students’ changing schedules. Each Sitters List will state the valid dates. The current Spring 2012 List is valid through May 2012.

As this list is generated by a student group, the administrator will change every year. This email address, however, will always put you in contact with the current administrator.
